Essentially a Côtes Du Rhône gone backpacking. Gutsy & spicy, warm, welcoming & more-ish

79 **Le Roc Classique 2008**, Cotes du Frontonnais, Midi-Pyrenees, France 23.75
Expressive of the Pyrenees, a touch rustic (by no means coarse) but offering fine balanced fruit, savoury & spice

80 **Clos Millésime 2009** (Carignan, Cab-Sauv, Merlot, Grenache), Dom Sainte Eugénie, Languedoc 23.50
A wine that's so fab (the Languedoc tipping its rakishly disheveled hat towards the Rhone valley). Spicy & dark

81 **Côtes du Rhône 'Cuvee Mistral' 2010**, Domaine Coulange, Rhone, France 25.25
Crunchy vibrant dark fruit, delicious spicy savoury notes & powerful but not heavy. That soft Irish day again

82 **Crozes Hermitage 2008**, Maison Paul Jaboulet Aîné, Northern Rhone, France 36.00
The essence of Crozes displaying savoury notes, olives, a dash of pepper, herbs, orange zest & soft red fruits

Old vine Grenache; inviting, appealing, savoury, bright fruit with both tone & balance. Truly worth looking at

Always happy to highlight re-discovered grape varieties. Lively summer forest fruit; full & good

88 **Refosco Riserva 2009**, Russolo, Friuli, Italy 29.00
A really lovely medium bodied red full of sweet dark brambly fruit & soft peppery notes that just linger

89 **Dolcetto d'Alba 2010**, Aldo Vajra, Piedmont, Italy 32.00
Perfumed & textured in that soft delicious plump Dolcetto way - all bright fruit & the rest

90 **Barbera d'Alba 2008**, Az Agr Bricco Maiolica, Piedmont, Italy 32.50
The 08 is lighter in style (ripe plums, crunchy tannins, spicy) than the beastly 07, but just as enjoyable

91 **Barbera 'Santa Andrea' 2008**, Vigne Marina Coppi, Colli Tortonesi, Piedmont, Italy 33.00
Utterly & utterly the grandest charming family find this year. Hand nurtured vines & a lovely plump ripe wine

92 **Cabernet Franc Riserva 2004**, Az Agr Letrari, Trentino, Italy 36.00
Like an elegant, plump, creamy, delicious blackcurrant driven Cab from Bordeaux, albeit one that's fairly priced

93 **Langhe Nebbiolo 2009**, Az Agr Bricco Maiolica, Piedmont, Italy 33.00
A classic Piemontese style from 16-28yr Nebbiolo vines (the Barolo varietal). Really rather gorgeous & convivial

94 **Langhe Nebbiolo 2008**, Az Agr Massolino, Serralunga d'Alba , Piedmont (C) 42.00
The Serralunga commune tends towards a firmer structured style of baby Barolo. Savoury, ripe & very more-ish

Smoky, savoury & pure, button bright tickling the tongue, brisk acidity & sweet fruit, & tannins thankfully tamed

Very much a favourite at The Oak. Succulent Sangiovese, concentrated cherries, ripe tannins, lively & right
